Percent of infants and toddlers with IFSPs who received the early intervention services on their IFSPs in a timely manner.

[SPP/APR #2](#)

Percent of infants and toddlers with IFSPs who primarily received early intervention services in their home or programs for typically developing peers.

[SPP/APR #4](#)

Percent at or above the measure that the state adopted as the standard for families participating in Part C who report that early intervention services have helped their family know their rights.

[SPP/APR #5](#)

Percent of infants and toddlers enrolled in an early intervention program between birth and 1 year of age.

[SPP/APR #6](#)

Percent of infants and toddlers enrolled in an early intervention program between birth and 3 years of age.

[SPP/APR #7](#)

Percent of infants and toddlers with IFSPs for whom an evaluation, assessment, and an initial IFSP meeting were conducted within Part C's 45-day timeline.

[SPP/APR #8A, B, and C](#)

A. Percent of all children exiting Part C who had an IFSP with transitional steps and services.

B. Percent of children exiting Part C and potentially eligible for Part B where notification to local education agency (LEA) occurred.

C. Percent of children exiting Part C where transition conference occurred.
