

CY 2009 – Long Term Care

The results indicate the top-10 citations, that is, provider non-compliance with regulatory requirements, cited during a calendar year (CY). The data reflect the most frequently cited deficiency to the least cited, in numeric order, and the title reflects the main regulatory section. NOTE: the “main regulatory section” may not accurately reflect the issues cited to arrive at the total number, as a single section (specific regulatory requirement) may deal with multiple aspects of a single regulatory requirement. That is, a citation involving neglect may have been cited multiple times, with differing content, as the scope of neglect can be far reaching. Regulatory requirements apply only to a specific provider group, such as ambulatory surgery center requirements only apply to that group and cannot be applied to hospitals, or vice versa.

Health surveys deal primarily with the day-to-day facility administration, management, functioning, services, and protection of beneficiary/family rights. *Life Safety Code* surveys deal primarily with adherence to regulatory requirements surrounding fire safety, building construction, emergency preparedness, and protective systems administration, management, and testing.
