Our state hospitals collaborate with patients and their families, as applicable, and the referring Regional Mental Health Centers to develop goals for hospitalization and arrange follow-up care after inpatient stays. Our hospitalization is intended to be of short to intermediate duration with the objective of stabilizing presenting symptoms and returning the patient to community living in the shortest reasonable period of time.

Treatment is individualized and delivered within interdisciplinary teams. Staff deliver a number of specialized services to include: assessments and evaluations, medication management, a variety of therapies, opportunities for community integration, involvement in recreational and educational activities and discharge planning. We use the Recovery Model in treatment and promote alignment with the patient in developing a self-directed care plan to assist in working towards their own recovery goals.
