Findings from FFY 2014 are from the Family Outcomes Survey-Revised (FOS-R) conducted by the Infant Toddler Program. * The Family Survey was completely revamped in FFY 2014, resulting in small sample sizes. Hence, data broken down at the regional level are not available for FFY 2014.




4A: Percent of Families Reporting that the Program Helped Them Know Their Rights
