<sup>1</sup> Death - Category for incidents where a child died at the location of, or as a result of participating in, child care.

<sup>2</sup> Serious Injury - Category for incidents regarding children that required hospitalization or a doctor's care. (This category is not used for minor injuries such as scrapes, diaper rash, or child-to-child biting.)

<sup>3</sup> Substantiated - After an investigation, if it is determined by the relevant authorities that an incident occurred, it is considered "substantiated".

<sup>4</sup> Substantiated Incidents are investigated and determined to have occurred by Law Enforcement in the region where the incident occurred.

<sup>5</sup> Data reflects the ACF 800 2018 Report. Data only includes counts of children receiving subsidy.
