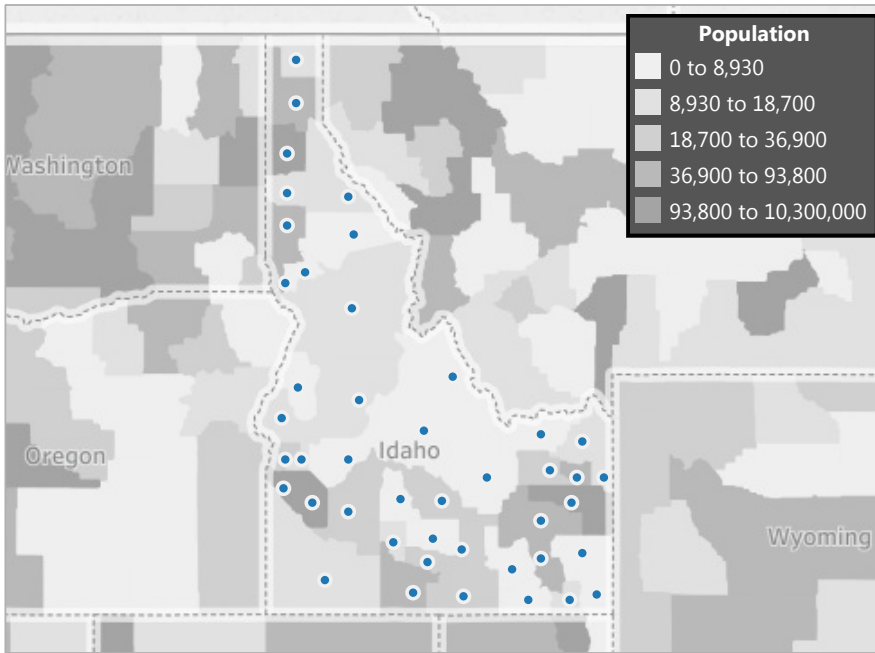

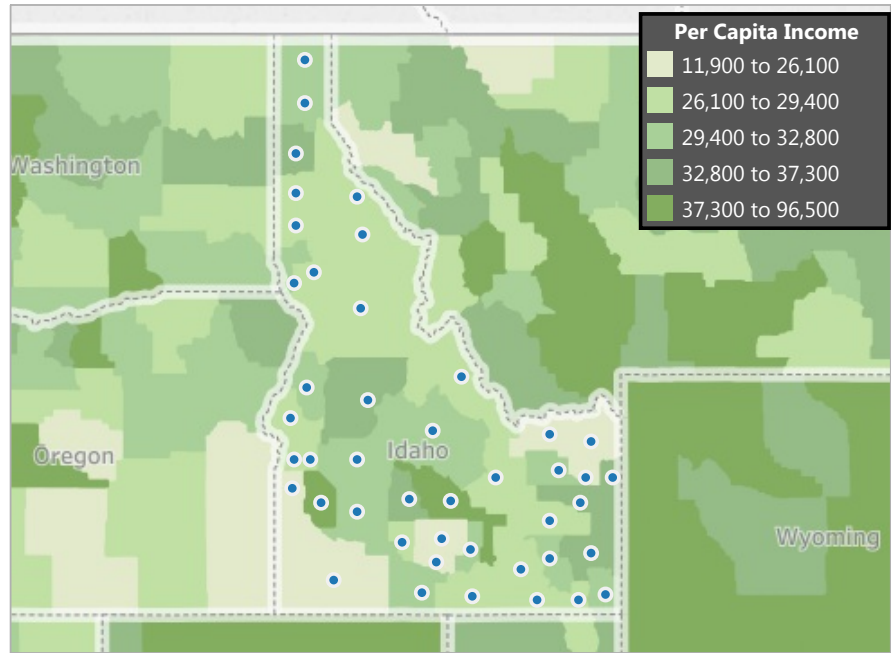

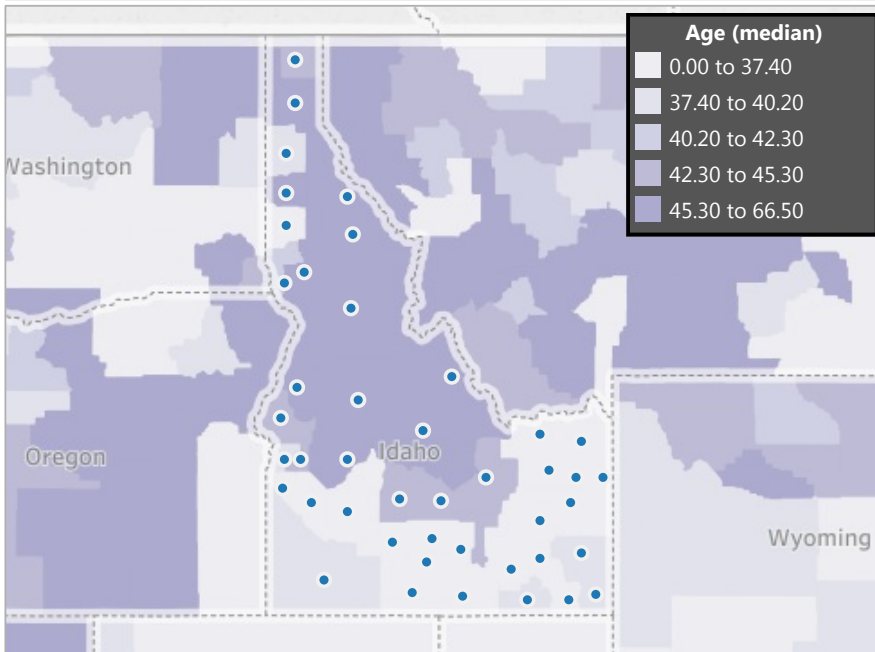

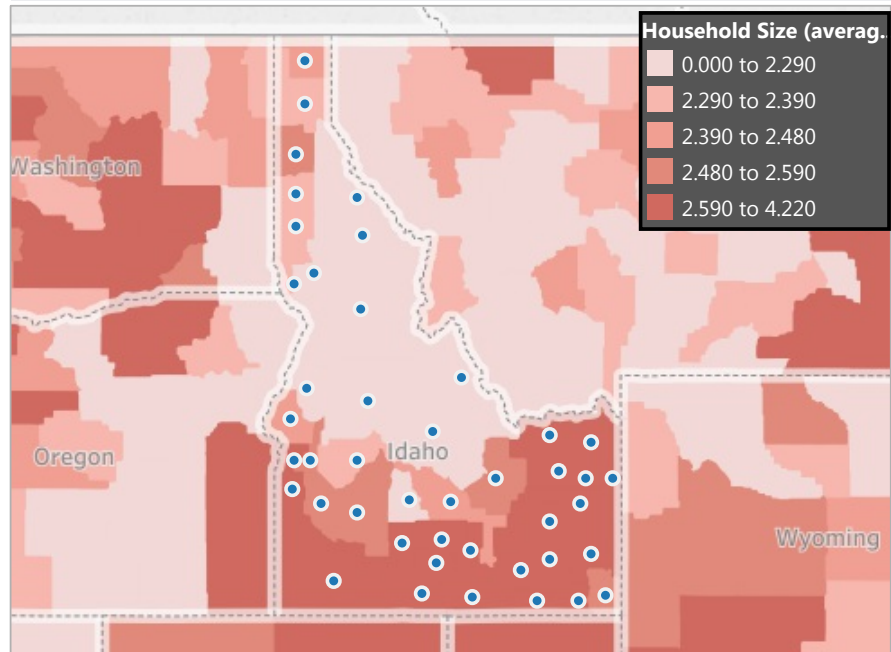
Income
