


How to Conduct a Search in the Formula Handbook

Three possible ways to use Find function with the Formula Handbook

1. Bring up the Formula Handbook:

- If your display looks the same as the picture below do the following:
 - Enter the term in the Find field (see red arrow)
 - Hit enter
 - The term that you are searching for will be highlighted in the text
 - There may be more than one result for your search, if this is the case Hit Enter until you find the correct example



2. Bring up the Formula Handbook:


- If you do not have the Find field, then you will need to Right Mouse Click. When a pop-up displays select Find (see red arrow)





3. The third search is very close to the second but with a twist. Bring up the Formula Handbook:
- Right Mouse Click. When a pop-up displays select Find (see red arrow)




- This should display in the upper right hand corner of the PDF document
- Click on the dropdown arrow




- This pop-up allows the user to choose different methods for the search
