



Breastfeeding Dyad Food Package: Issuing 100% formula

On the infant's Assign Food Package pop-up box:	On the woman's Assign Food Package pop-up box:
<p>BF%: 0% BF = 100% Formula</p> <p>Mother BF%: 25% BF = 75% Formula</p>	<p>BF%: 25% = 75% Formula</p>
<p>BF% needs to be 0% BF = 100% formula for infant to be eligible for a 100% formula food package.</p>	<p>BF% needs to be 25% BF = 75% formula for woman to be eligible for a food package 6.</p>

Reminder: Assign Category B if a woman is feeding her breast milk to her infant averaging at least once a day.

Although there is a message stating, “**For breastfeeding infants, formula should not be issued to an infant less than 1 month of age,**” formula may still be issued using the above method after providing counseling as described in the Idaho WIC Program Policy Manual 6-A-6.
