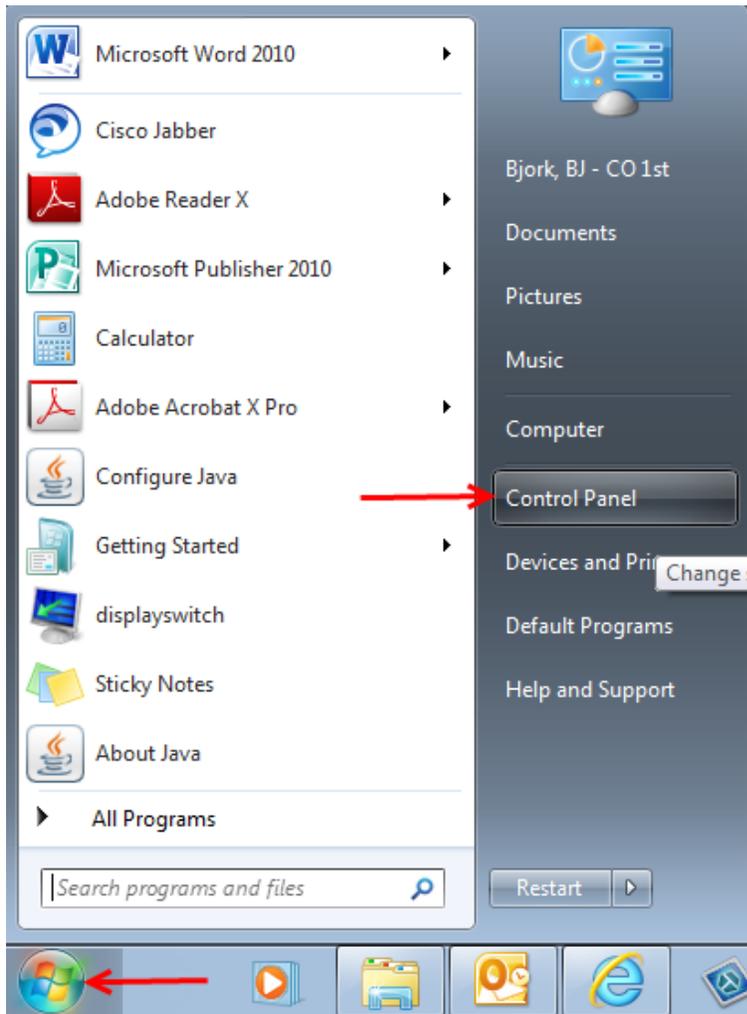


The Work Around For TRAIN.org

If you launch a course and receive a message stating that JAVA on your computer needs updating, see below for the work around.

1. Log into the computer
2. Click on the start button on the lower left side of the screen. Then select click on control panel.



3. Click on Programs.

4. Click on the Java icon.

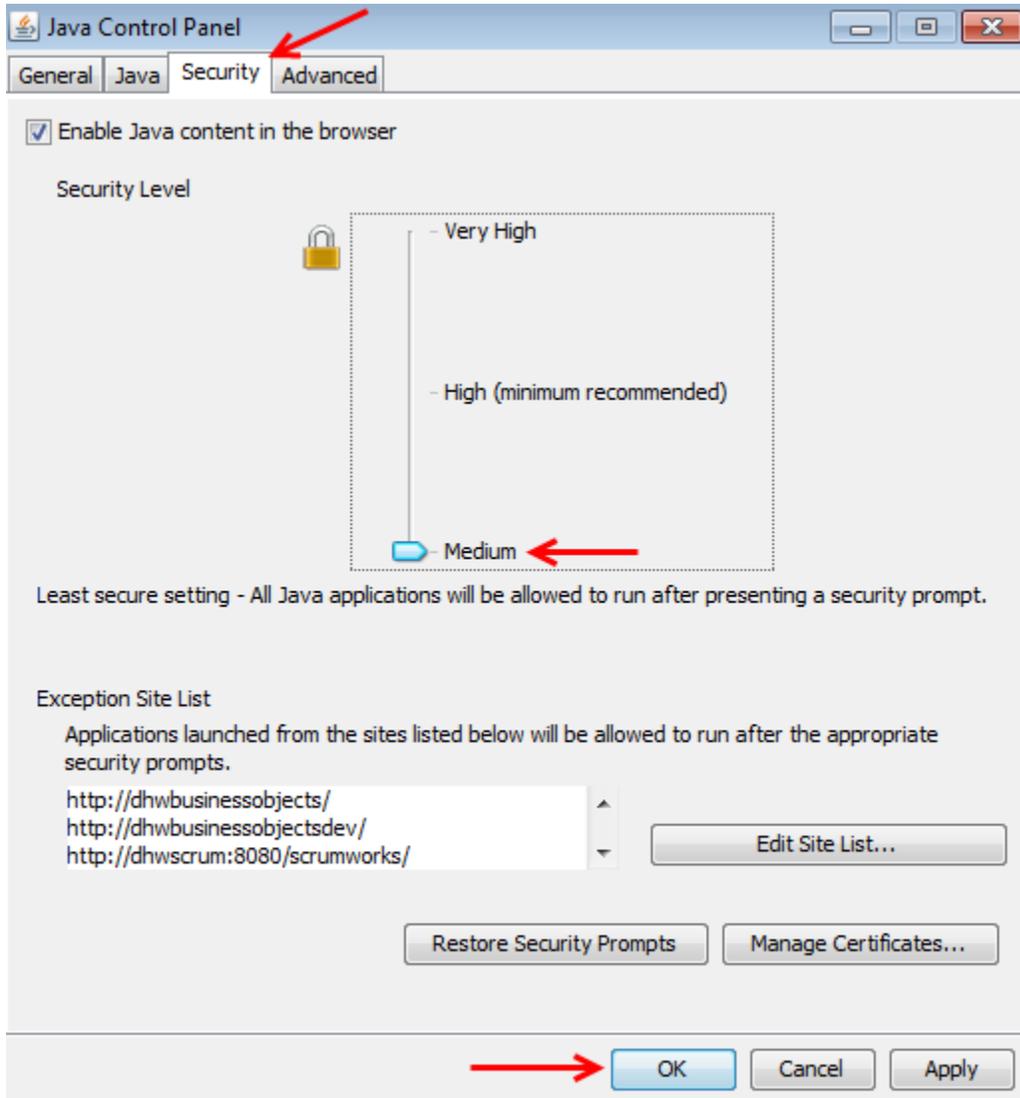

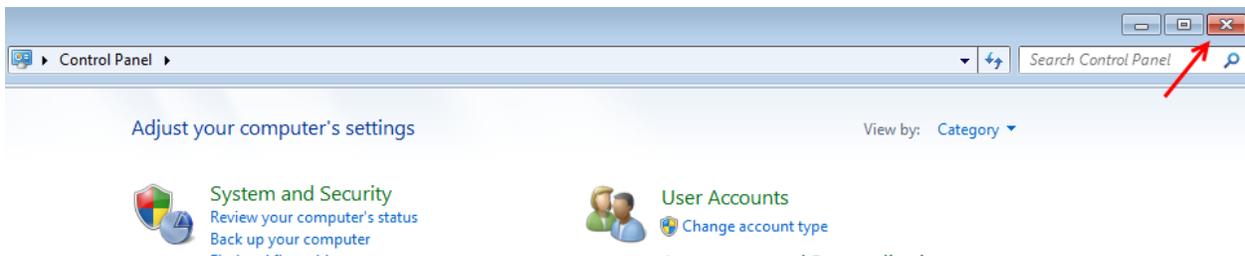

5. This will bring up the Java window, select Security from the top tabs. Now move the bar down to medium and click ok.

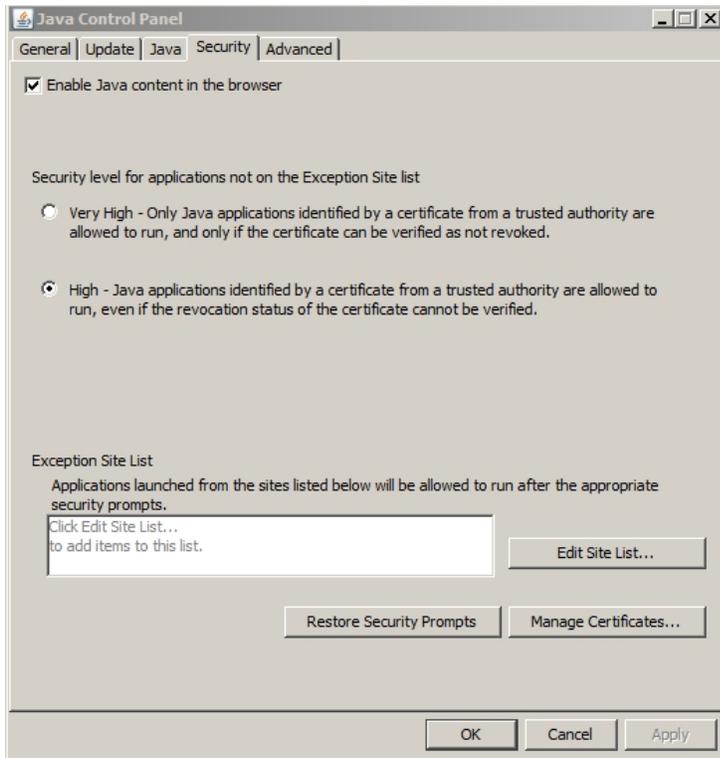


6. Close the control panel by selecting the X in the upper left hand of the window.

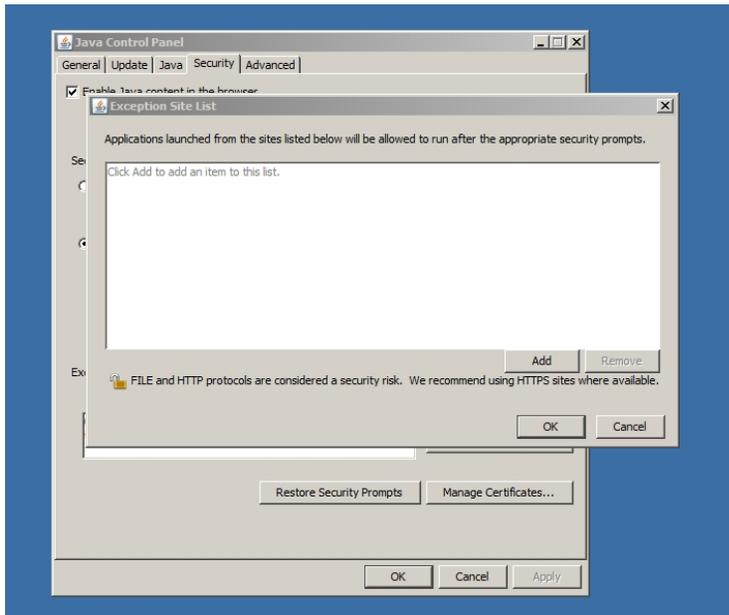

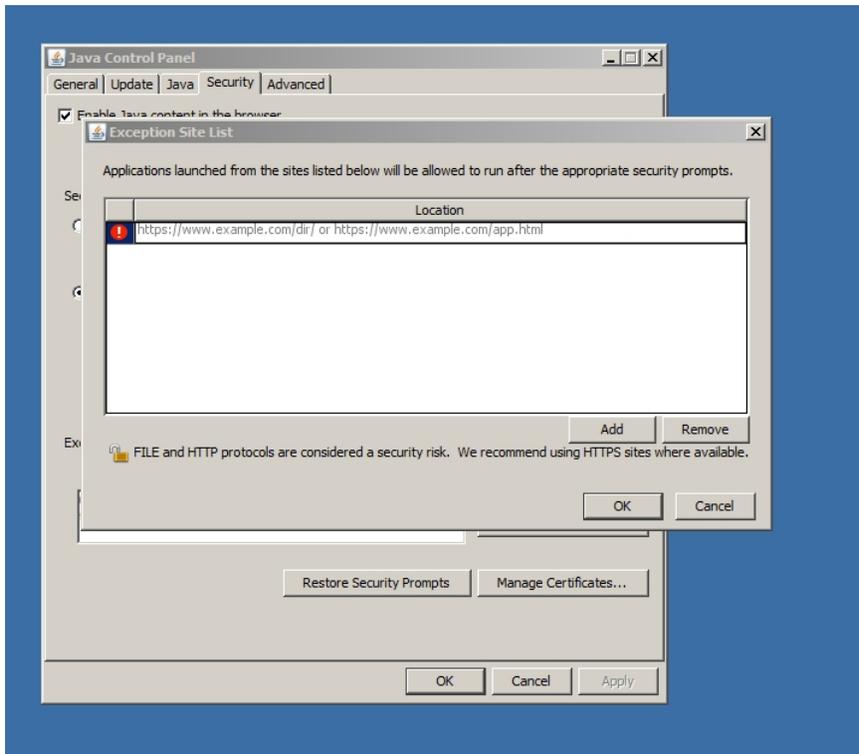
1. Click on computer start in the Search programs and files field enter Java
2. On the Java Control Panel select the Security Tab
3. Click on Edit Site List button



4. Click on the Add button

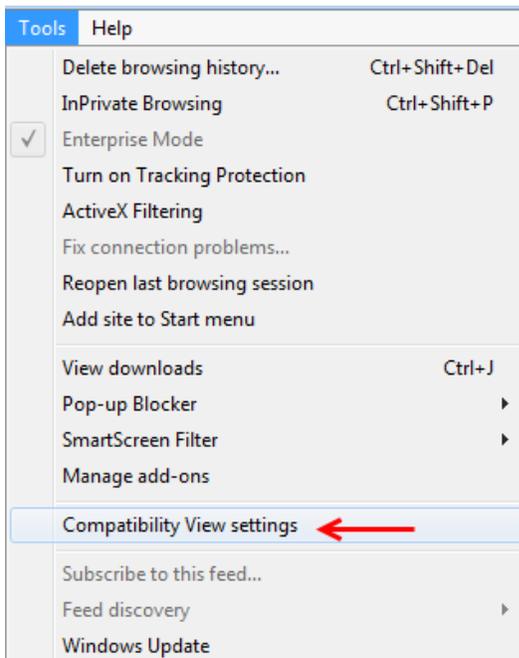


5. Enter <http://id.train.org>
6. Click on Add
7. Enter <http://courses.az.train.org>
8. Click on the OK button (Exception Site List popup)
9. Click on the OK button (Java Control Panel)

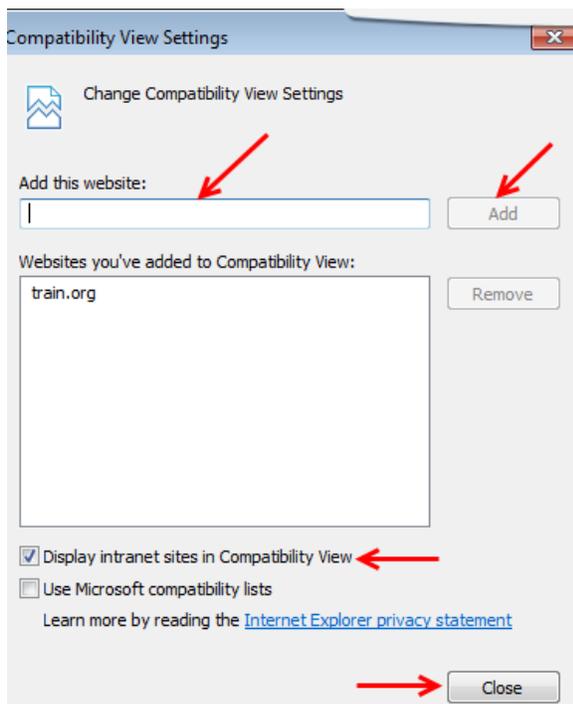


Compatibility View Settings:

1. Open Internet Explorer, then from the tools menu click on Compatibility View settings.

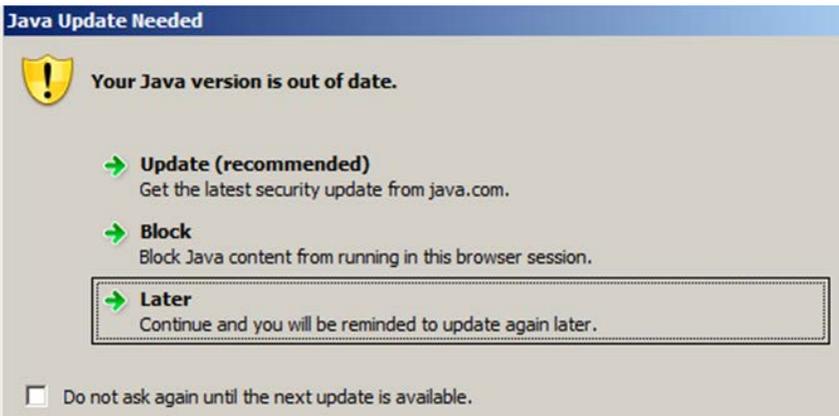


2. Now type train.org click add. Next click the box that says Display Internet sites in Compatibility View and click close.

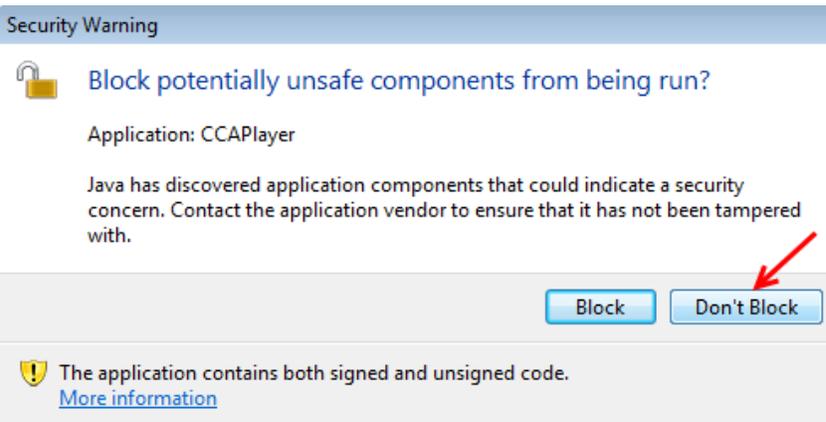


3. Login to id.train.org. You should be able to use the training site now as normal however you may see the following messages.

5. Select Don't Block



6. Click the box that says I accept the risk and want to run this app. This will allow the run button to be clicked. Now go ahead and click run.
