

To qualify for WIC services, you must:

- Live in Idaho
- Be one of the following:
 - pregnant or recently pregnant
 - breastfeeding a baby under one year of age
 - an infant or child under the age of 5
- Have a nutritional need
- Meet the income guidelines below

WIC INCOME ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

1	\$21,590
2	\$29,101
3	\$36,612
4	\$44,123
5	\$51,634
6	\$59,145
7	\$66,656
8	\$74,167

For each additional individual, add \$7,511/year
One pregnant woman counts as 2 household members
