

Idaho Comprehensive Cancer Control Program Year in Review: July 2017- June 2018



- Partnered with 26 outdoor/recreation facilities throughout the state.
- Provided sun safety education to 200+ staff.
- Implemented sun safety policies and environmental changes, including shade sails, educational signage, and sunscreen dispensers, reaching an estimated 870,000 individuals.



- Partnered with 22 child-care facilities throughout the state.
- Provided sun safety education to 280+ staff.
- Implemented sun safety policies and environmental changes, including shade sails and sunscreen dispensers, reaching an estimated 1,500 youth.



- Partnered with 16 primary care or pediatric clinic locations.
- Provided HPV vaccination education to 190 clinic staff.
- Conducted health system data validation and implemented patient reminder/recall systems to impact 8,800 youth due for HPV vaccination.



HPV Free Idaho facilitated HPV Vaccination Week, February 5-9, 2018. A total of 45 providers and organizations participated in events across the state.



CCAI hosted its annual meeting in October 2017. Best practices from around the state were shared along with progress toward the goals of the Idaho Comprehensive Cancer Plan.
