Practicum participation is limited to 6 students; early registration is imperative. Register for the Clinical Practicum when you register for the STD Update in Boise, Idaho.

After receiving confirmation of their acceptance participants will schedule practicum sessions directly through the Central District Health Department. Practicum participants must produce evidence of workers' compensation and liability insurance coverage for their participation in the clinical practicum at the CDHD STD Clinic and such documentation of this insurance must be submitted to the clinic in advance of practicum.

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This course is designed for clinicians practicing in Idaho who have completed the STD Update course held in Boise on September 17-18, 2013 and who have at least six months STD exam experience.

The STD Clinical Practicum includes basic examination skills, skill development in sexual history taking, review of clinical case studies and hands-on experience in the STD clinic and laboratory under the direct supervision of a skilled preceptor.

By the end of the course participants will be able to:

- ✓ Elicit and record a focused sexual history.
- ✓ Perform thorough STD examinations on both male and female patients.
- ✓ Collect and perform STAT laboratory tests for the diagnosis of STD.

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Continuing Nursing Education: A certificate for up to **12.0 hours** will be awarded for completing all course activities, a pre/post test and an evaluation.

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
