

Definition of Idaho's Family Planning Program:

Idaho Family Planning is a Title X partially federal funded program for women and men ages 10-55 years with contraceptive needs to space and plan families confidentially. It promotes healthier sexual life styles by screening for breast and cervical cancer, hypertension, anemia and works collaboratively with other STD programs providing testing and treatment. It provides education and counseling for reproductive and preventive health, self breast/testicular examination, contraceptive methods, STD/HIV risks and infertility. Sliding fee scales for services are assessed based on income and no one is refused services because of inability to pay.
