- ❖ Receive practical tips, models and tools for integrating hepatitis screening, counseling, vaccination, treatment and referrals for care into your current work setting.
- ❖ Identify resources to support you in your work.

Prerequisite: There is no prerequisite for this training.

Audience: This training is for health and human services providers who work in a variety of settings that serve people at high risk for viral hepatitis including public health / STD clinics, HIV prevention substance use treatment settings, correctional settings, care or support services.
