This course is designed for nurses practicing in Idaho who have completed the STD Update course held in Boise, Idaho August 14, 2014 and who have at least six months STD exam experience.

**The STD Clinical Practicum includes basic examination skills, skill development in sexual history taking, review of clinical case studies and hands-on experience in the STD clinic and laboratory under the direct supervision of a skilled preceptor.**

By the end of the course participants will be able to:

- ✓ Elicit and record a focused sexual history.
- ✓ Perform thorough STD examinations on both male and female patients.
- ✓ Collect and perform STAT laboratory tests for the diagnosis of STD.
