Paul A. Offit, M.D. is the Director of the Vaccine Education Center at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia as well as the Maurice R. Hilleman Professor of Vaccinology and a Professor of Pediatrics at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. He is a recipient of many awards and the author of more than 160 papers in medical and scientific journals and six books. Dr. Offit is also the co-inventor of the rotavirus vaccine, RotaTeq.



Andrew Kroger, M.D., M.P.H., is a medical officer for the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. As one of the traveling trainers in the Education, Information, and Partnership Branch, Dr. Kroger has given multiple presentations on topics ranging from immunization updates to pandemic influenza preparedness.
