WILLIAM L. ATKINSON, MD, MPH

William Atkinson, MD, MPH, is a former Medical Epidemiologist with the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in Atlanta, Georgia. He worked for 25 years on a variety of immunization-related activities including the development of national immunization policy. Dr. Atkinson retired from the CDC in 2012 and is now an independent consultant for the development of technical and training materials for immunization providers. He currently serves as the Associate Director for Immunization Education for the Immunization Action Coalition. Dr. Atkinson conceived, developed, and took the lead in writing one of the CDC's most widely sought-after books, *Epidemiology and Prevention of Vaccine-Preventable Diseases* (aka the Pink Book).
