Dr. Paul A. Offit, M.D. is the Director of the Vaccine Education Center at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia as well as the Maurice R. Hilleman Professor of Vaccinology and a Professor of Pediatrics at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. He is a recipient of many awards, the author of more than 160 papers in medical and scientific journals, and six books. Dr. Offit is also the co-inventor of the rotavirus vaccine, RotaTeq.



Dr. Andrew Kroger, M.D., M.P.H., is a medical officer for the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
