FEATURED SPEAKERS



Rebecca Coyle, MS Ed is the Executive Director for the American Immunization Registry Association (AIRA). She has served in this role since 2010 and oversees the development and promotion of tools and standards for the implementation of immunization information systems. Ms. Coyle began working with immunizations in 2002 as a school and childcare coordinator in a state health department. Since that time she has worked as a Public Health Advisor for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and as a state immunization program manager. Ms. Coyle has a master's degree in education and public health. Her work with AIRA plays an important role in preventing and controlling vaccine preventable diseases.



JoEllen Wolicki, BSN, RN is a Nurse Educator for the Communication and Education Branch at the CDC. Prior to joining the CDC, she served five years as a statewide Nurse Consultant to the Division of Immunization under the Michigan Department of Community Health. Ms. Wolicki is a member of the Childhood Immunization Schedule, General Recommendations, Pertussis Vaccination, and Human Papillomavirus Vaccination workgroups for the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). Her work

includes educating immunization providers by developing integrative educational training curriculum and materials. Ms. Wolicki has conducted a number of national immunization presentations. Some of her current projects include delivering web-based trainings from the CDC's Epidemiology and Vaccine Preventable Disease Course (aka the Pink Book) and "Keys to Storage and Handling Your Vaccine Supply."



William Atkinson, MD, MPH is a former Medical Epidemiologist with the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases at the CDC in Atlanta, Georgia. He worked for 25 years on a variety of immunization-related activities including the development of national immunization policy. Dr. Atkinson retired from CDC in 2012 and is now an independent consultant for the development of technical and training materials for immunization providers. He currently serves as the Associate Director for Immunization Education

for the Immunization Action Coalition. Dr. Atkinson conceived, developed, and took the lead in writing one of the CDC's most widely sought-after books, the Pink Book.


