Specimen Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Specimen type(s): serum (0.5 mL) or plasma. Acceptable anticoagulants: serum separator tube (SST), EDTA, lithium heparin, sodium heparin, sodium citrate2. Separated serum should remain at room temperature (20-25°C) for no longer than 8 hours. Otherwise, serum should be refrigerated at 2-8°C.3. Rejection criteria: saliva, oral fluid, urine
