The Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders Fifth Edition (DSM-5) is used nationally and internationally to provide standardized criteria for clinical and research use. Release of DSM-5 marks the first major revision to the classification of and diagnostic criteria for mental disorders since DSM-IV was released in 1994.


