


IDAHO ORAL HEALTH NETWORK - 2015 Inaugural Meetings

Did you know?


3 out of 5 adults with diabetes had one or more teeth removed due to periodontal disease or tooth decay


 Almost **half (49%)** of Idaho women lacked routine dental care during pregnancy


3 out of 5 (62%) Idaho children between ages 6-9 experience caries (National goal = 49%)


 At least **3 out of 4** third-grade Hispanic students have caries
