MARRIAGE

Idaho

The number of marriages occurring in Idaho increased 3.7 percent from 13,207 in 2013 to 13,699 in 2014. The marriage rate increased from 8.2 marriages per 1,000 population to 8.4 per 1,000 population. Marriages occur at a higher frequency in Idaho than in the U.S. as a whole; the 2014 U.S. provisional marriage rate was 6.9 per 1,000. Much of the difference between Idaho and U.S. rates can be accounted for by the high number of nonresidents who marry in northern Idaho.

On October 15, 2014, same-sex marriage became legal in Idaho, and a question for each person's title (groom, bride, or partner) was added to the Idaho Marriage License. Marriage licenses vary by county; some counties also have a question for sex, and some counties do not include a question for sex. Of the 13,699 marriages in Idaho in 2014, 11,239 occurred prior to October 15, and were between a groom and a bride. A total of 2,050 marriages occurred on or after October 15 and the titles were listed as groom and bride. There were a total of 13,289 marriages between a bride and groom in Idaho in 2014. A total of 410 marriages were same-sex or between a partner and a partner, and occurred on or after October 15, 2014.

Opposite-sex, Same-sex, and Partner and Partner Marriages

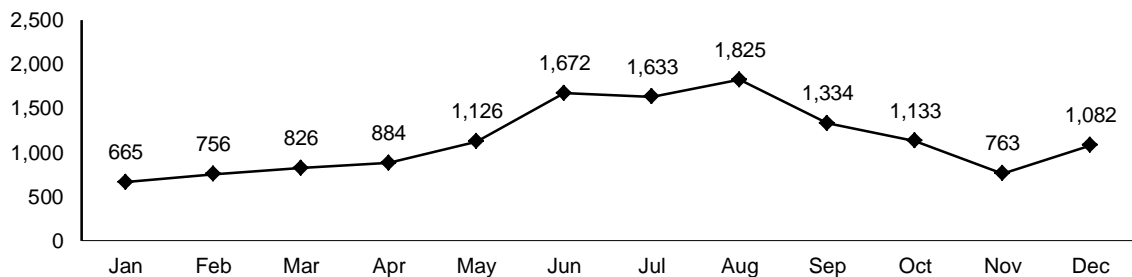
To utilize the data collected on title of spouses, data on age and race are displayed in three separate tables. The first table called "Total Marriages" is based on 13,699 marriages occurring in Idaho, regardless of the title of spouse. The first spouse may be a groom, a bride, or a partner; the second spouse may be a groom, a bride, or a partner. The second table called "Opposite-sex Marriages" is based on 13,289 marriages in Idaho between a groom and a bride. The third table called "Same-Sex Or Marriages Between Partner and Partner" is based on 410 marriages between a groom and a groom, a bride and a bride, or a partner and a partner.

DIVORCE

Idaho

The number of divorces occurring in Idaho decreased 4.2 percent from 7,248 in 2013 to 6,943 in 2014. In the past ten years, the divorce rate declined 16.0 percent from 5.0 per 1,000 population in 2005 to 4.2 in 2014. Like marriages, divorces occur more frequently in Idaho than in the remainder of the nation; the 2014 U.S. provisional divorce rate was 3.2 per 1,000 population.

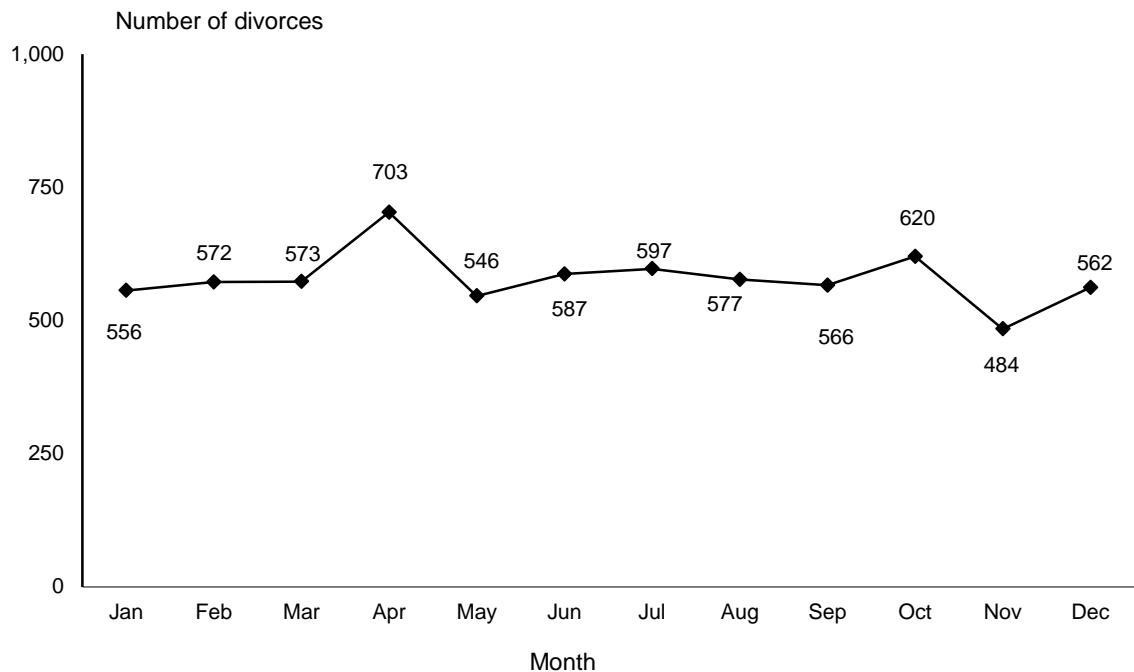
