POPULATION

Idaho

Since the last census in 2010, Idaho's population increased by 66,882 residents from 1,567,582 to 1,634,464 in 2014. In the past few years, the West South Central states (Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas) experienced the highest growth rate with 5.8 percent. The Mountain states region (Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah, and Wyoming) experienced the second highest growth rate at 5.1 percent. North Dakota experienced the highest growth rate (9.9 percent) in the nation, and West Virginia lost 0.1 percent of their population from 2010 to 2014. In the Mountain states, Utah and Colorado had the highest growth rates (6.5 percent). Idaho was tied for 13th highest growth rate in the nation with North Carolina (4.3 percent).

Counties

Idaho counties that experienced the largest percentage increases from April 1, 2010 to July 1, 2014 were Ada, Canyon, Kootenai, and Twin Falls. Numerically, Ada, Canyon, Kootenai, and Bonneville gained the most population. Clark, Butte, Camas, and Custer Counties reflected the greatest percentage decreases. Numerically, Elmore, Gooding, Shoshone, and Fremont experienced the greatest losses in population from 2010 to 2014.

Cities

Of the Idaho cities with at least 1,000 population in 2014, Star experienced the highest growth rate since 2010 (20.6 percent growth), followed by Marsing (20.4 percent growth), Meridian (14.4 percent growth), and Middleton with 14.0 percent growth. Cities under 1,000 population in 2014 with highest growth rates were State Line (13.6 percent), Franklin (13.5 percent), Kootenai (11.9 percent), and Clifton (8.5 percent).

Race

The National Center for Health Statistics contracts with the U.S. Census Bureau to develop and disseminate detailed population estimates for the states. These population estimates include "bridged" race data in which multiple race estimates are allocated to four single races. In 2014, 95.0 percent of Idaho's population was white, 1.2 percent was Black, 2.0 percent was American Indian or Alaska Native, and 1.9 percent was Asian or Pacific Islander. Persons of Hispanic ethnicity may be of any race. In 2014, 12.0 percent of Idaho's population was Hispanic and 88.0 percent of the population was non-Hispanic.


