On September 8, 2016 there will be a ceremony in the Idaho Capitol where Lt. Governor Brad Little will present the signed 2016 Recovery Month proclamation. Visual and written art will be on display to the public during this time. Submissions may be posted on the DBH website following the event. Please keep in mind that the audience will be those who are 13 and older, so material containing graphic material or nudity may not be displayed.
