We are providing this *2015 Women's Health Check Provider Update Packet* to keep you informed of program changes and requirements. **Thank you** for another successful year of screening and early detection of Idaho women. Your continuing relationship with Women's Health Check makes this possible!

In order to continue this partnership, **we are requiring all current WHC Providers to renew their Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and W-9 Form.** Department policy mandates a starting (date of signature by IDHW's Division of Management Services, Financial Manager), and termination date for all MOAs. This will be a yearly renewal requirement in the spring, to be signed and returned on or before June 1st of each year. This will be necessary to ensure reimbursement of services provided after June 30th of each year. If the renewed MOA and W-9 are not in place by June 30th, claims will be irreversibly denied.

The *2015 Women's Health Check Provider Update Packet* also includes the 2015 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Reimbursement Rates, 2015 WHC Eligibility Guidelines, and a current list of WHC Enrollment Centers.

Please take a moment to review the materials and ensure that the correct recipient is identified. We would also appreciate your agency/establishment/business providing us with an email contact to assist with future communication of important programmatic and claims reimbursement information.
