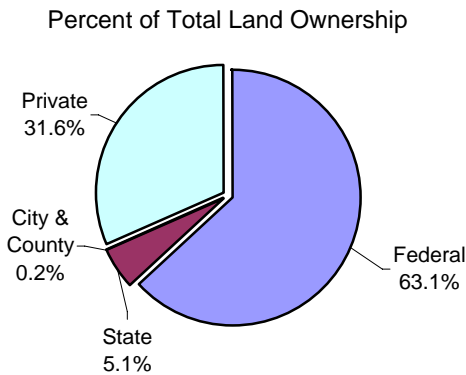

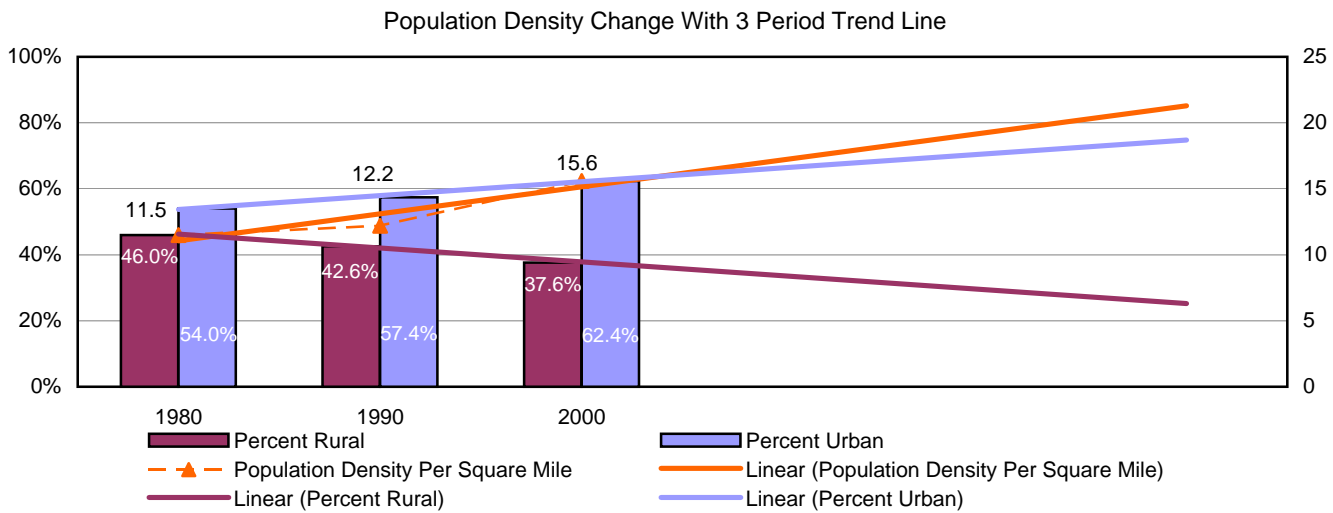

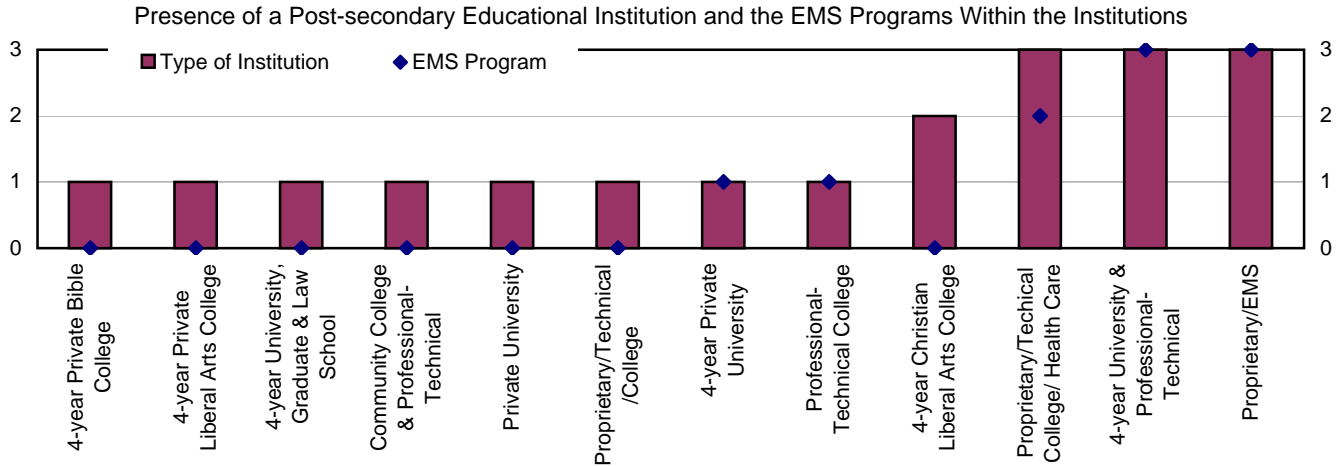
Idaho is located in the northwestern United States, bordering Canada and the states of Washington, Oregon, Nevada, Utah, Wyoming and Montana. It ranks 39th among the states in population and 11th in size. The federal government owns 63 percent of the state. Manufacturing, agriculture and tourism are important components of Idaho's economy. Annual average total civilian employment grew 24.5 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Bechtel BWXT Idaho (the prime contractor at the Idaho National Laboratory) J.R. Simplot Company, Albertsons, Inc., Fred Meyer, Inc./Kroger, Hewlett-Packard Company, Micron Technology, Potlatch Corporation, Wal-Mart, Mountain Home Air Force Base, BYU-Idaho, CH2MWG Idaho, St. Alphonsus Regional Medical Center, St. Luke's Regional Medical Center, Wells Fargo Bank and Boise Cascade Corporation.

With abundant mountains, lakes and streams, Idaho is a scenic and recreational playground with a beautiful four-season climate averaging 230 days of sunshine per year. While these characteristics helped establish Idaho as a natural resource producer, the state has evolved with a thriving and diversified economy.

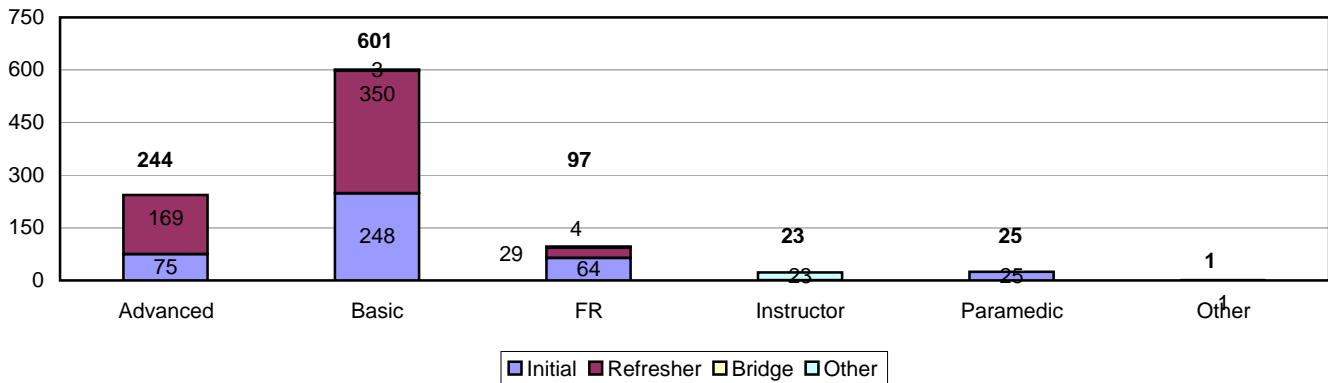

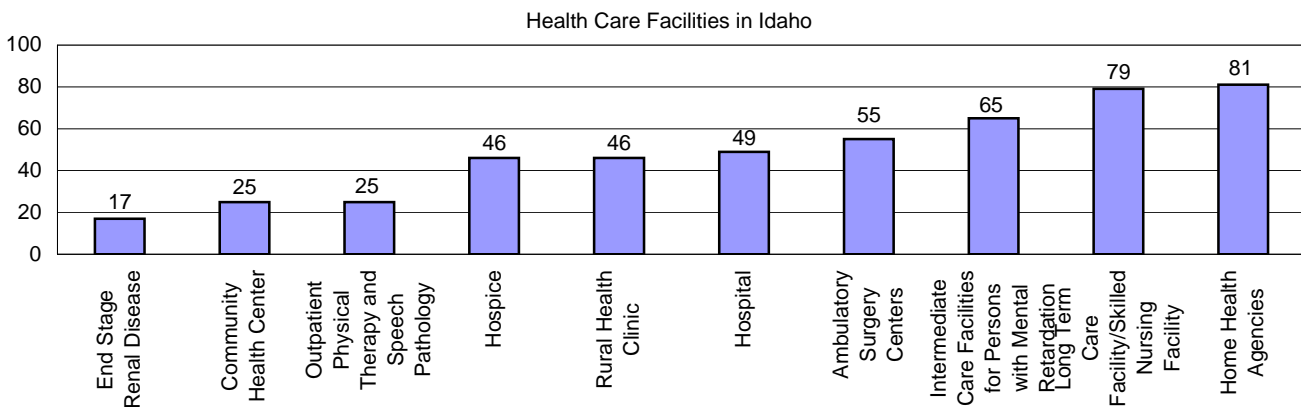


### Level and Type of Courses



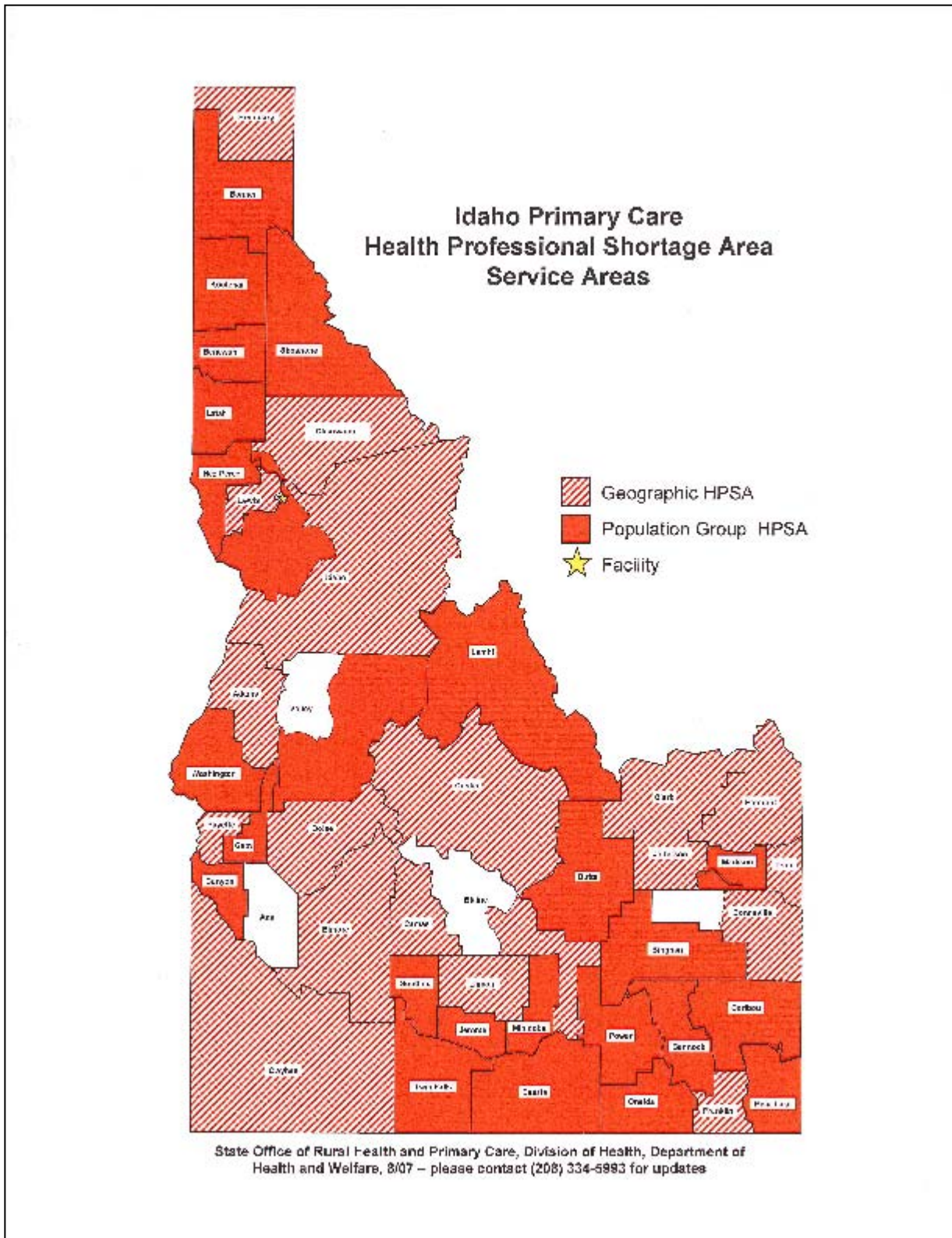

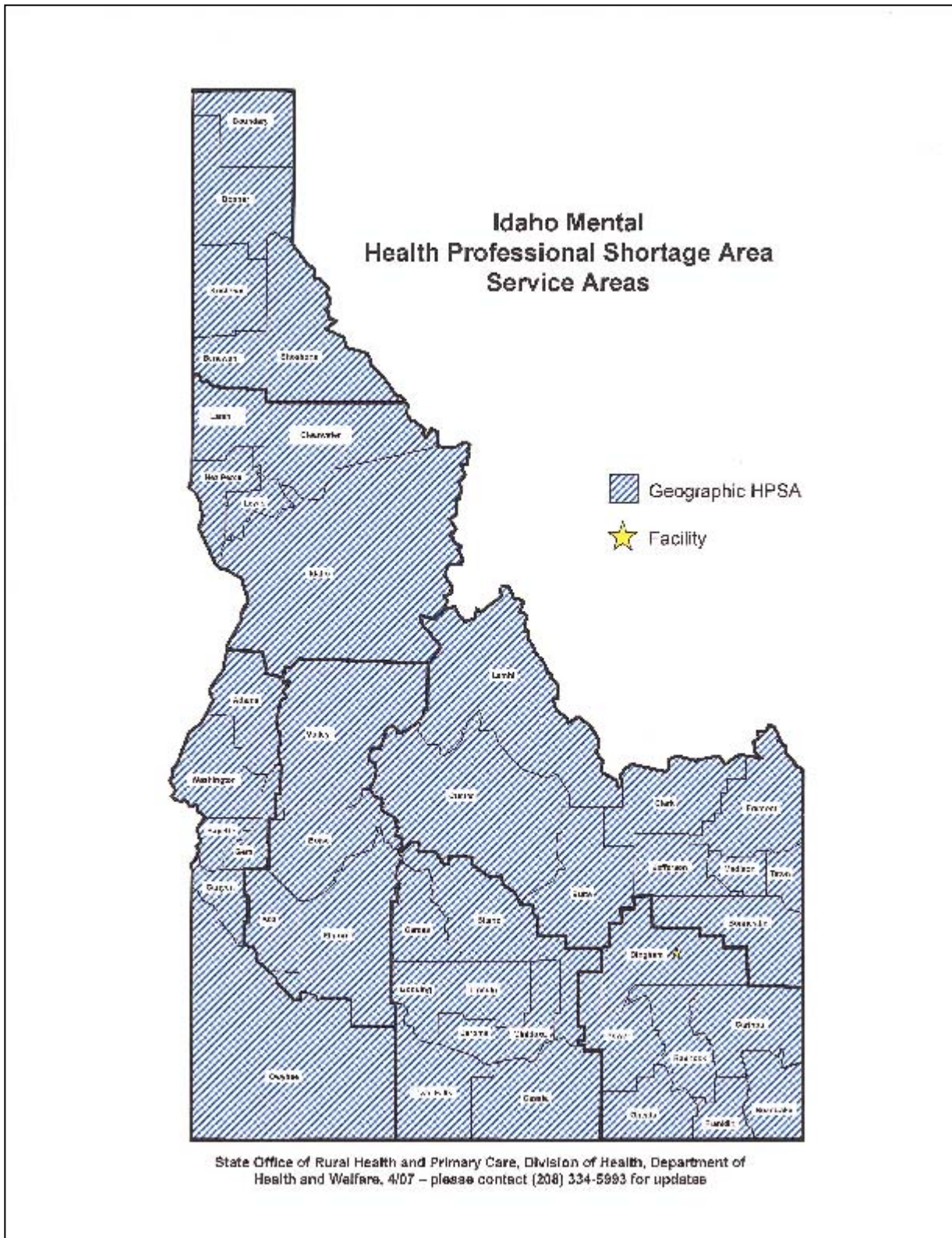

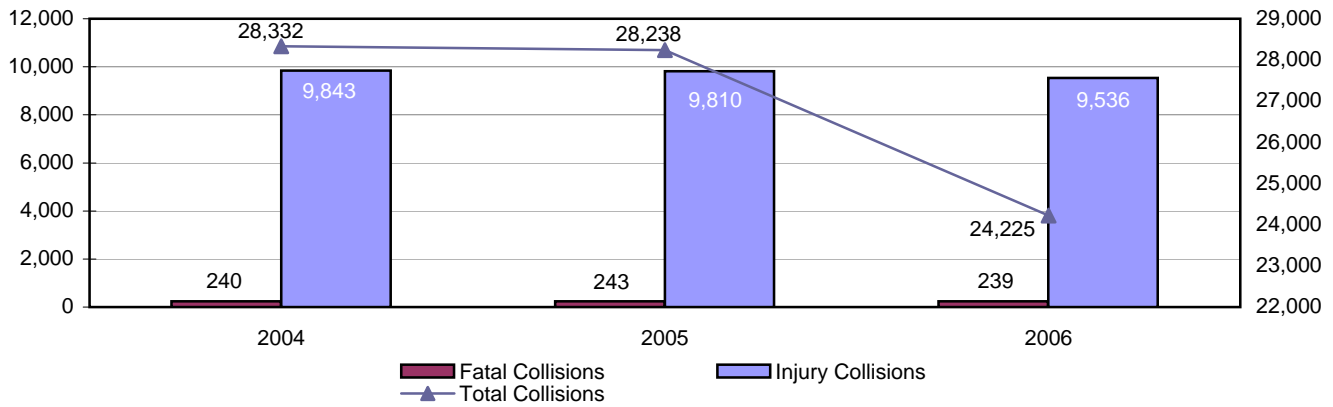

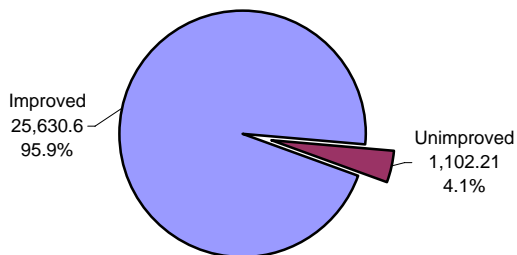

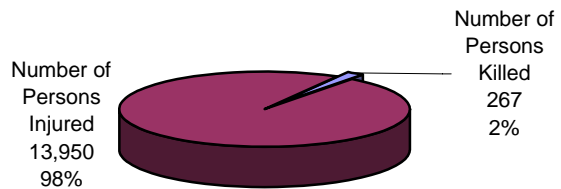
Collision History 2004-2006

Population = 3.4



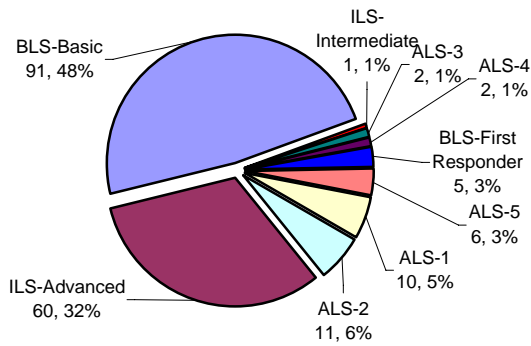

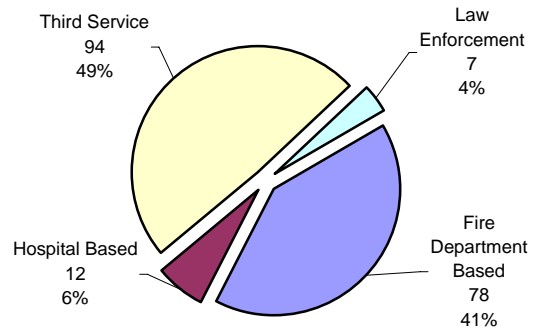

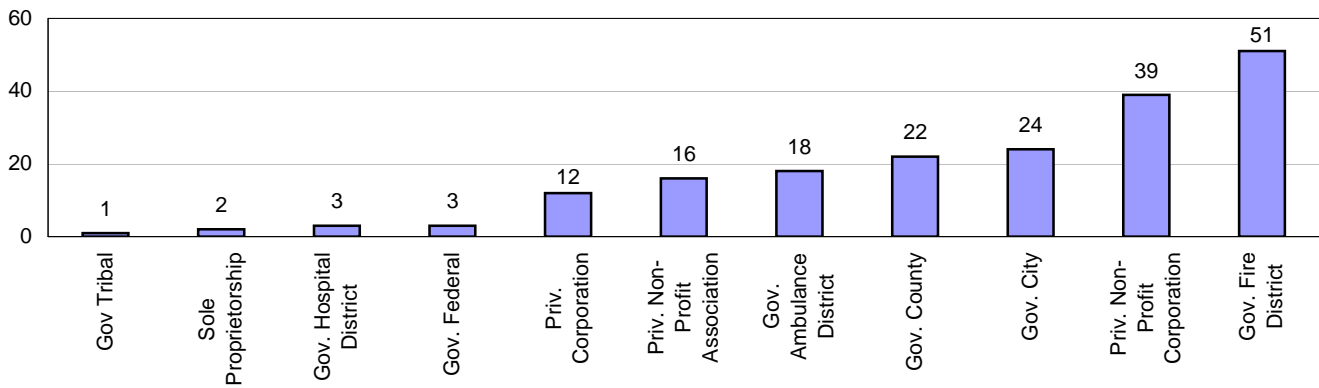
EMS Agency Licensure Levels



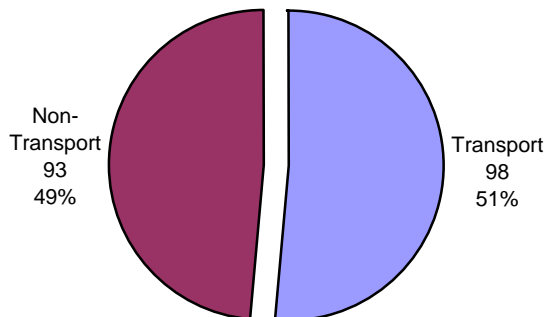
EMS Agency Classification



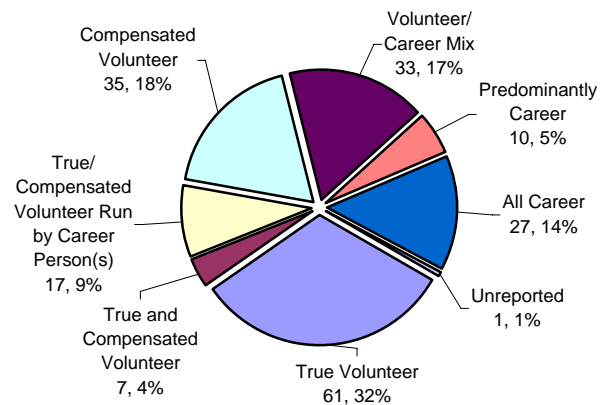
EMS Agency Structure



EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport

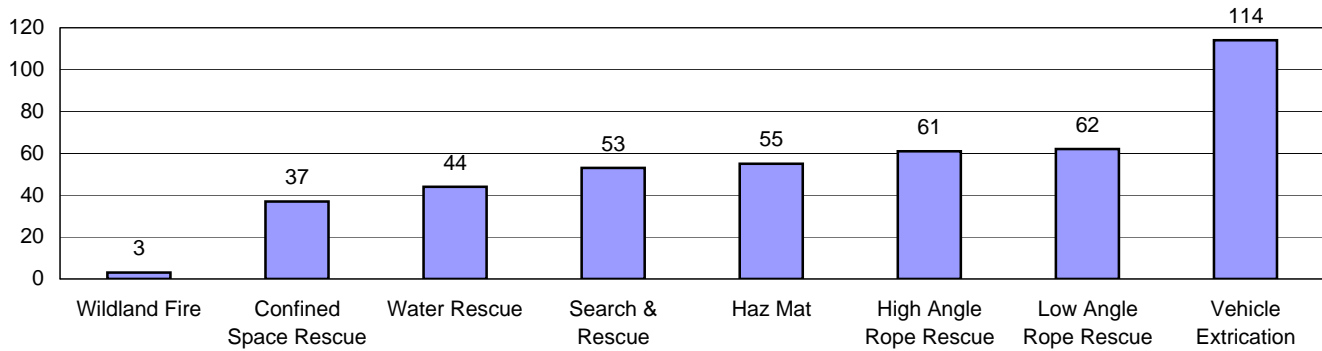


EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



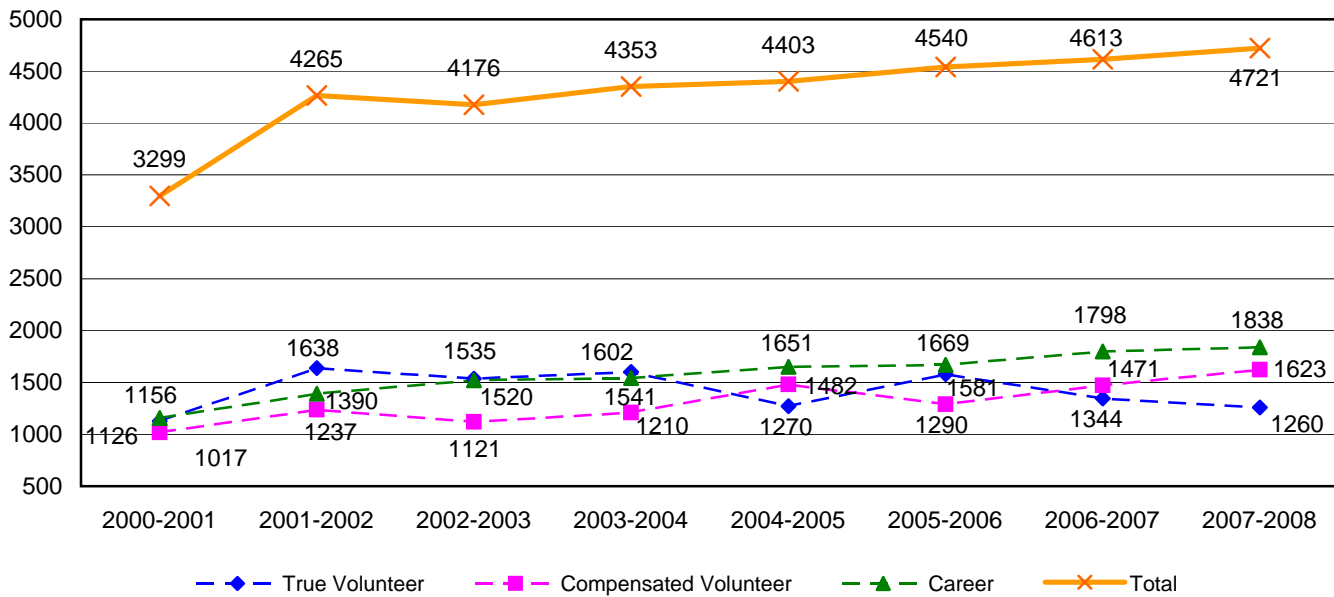

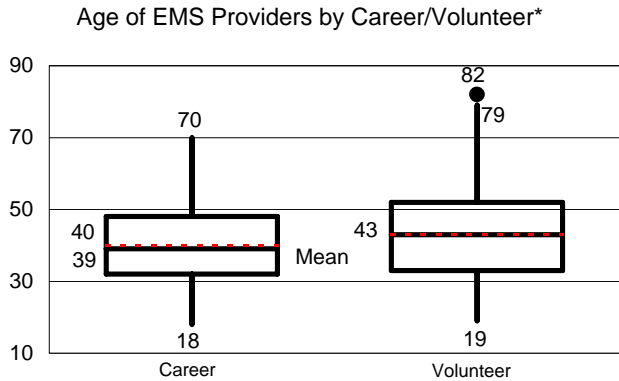

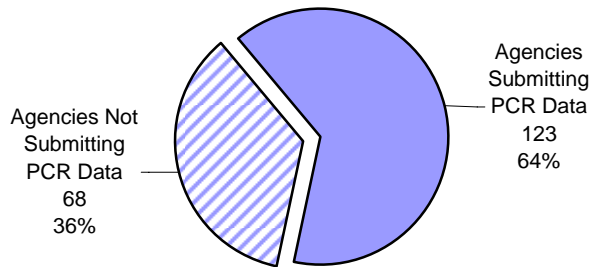

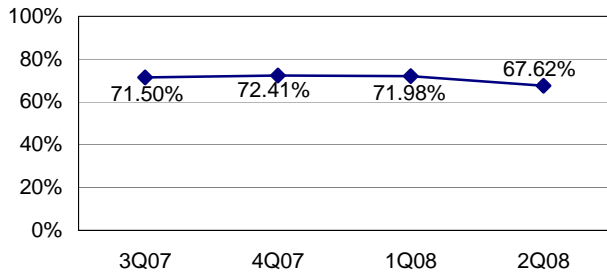
## Patient Care Reports (PCR)

Out of all 191 EMS Agencies in Idaho, 123 agencies submitted PCR data to the EMS Bureau between Jan 2007 - Dec 2007.

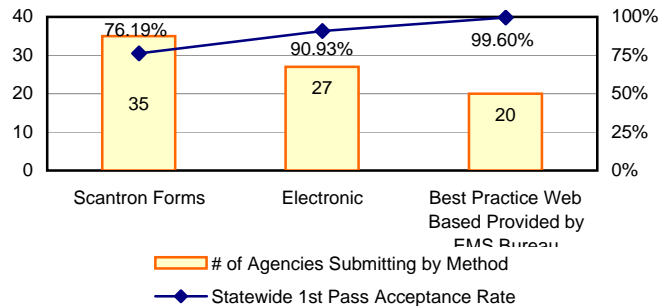
All Transport and Non-Transport Agency PCR Submissions

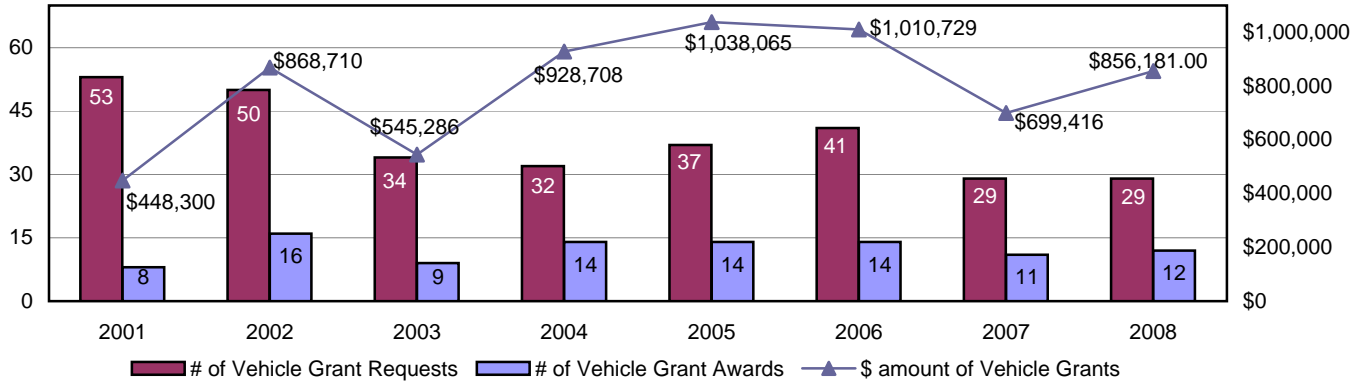

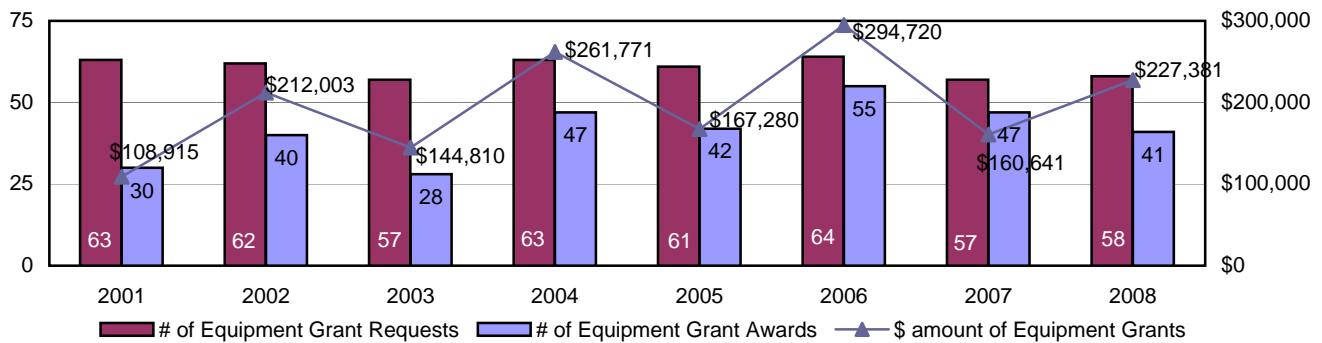
### Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
