Conference Summary: Content will be geared toward those caring for sick and injured kids. Content will include lectures on Pediatric trauma, current practice for pediatric illnesses, medications, burns, and psychiatric emergencies.



## About the Event

Friday during the reception there will be a panel presentation on the upcoming Emergency Pediatric Preparedness Guidelines from the National Pediatric Preparedness Project presented by Wyoming and Idaho EMS for children (EMSC). For those who are interested we will then have a combined WY/ID ENA meeting.

Saturday and Sunday there will be speakers presenting on burn management, emergency airways and other respiratory emergencies, pharmacology, sepsis, psychiatric emergencies, diabetic emergencies, trauma, medication management, toxicology and other pediatric emergencies.

In addition, there will be opportunities for hands on simulation and emergency skills practice including an ultrasound lab for practicing IV placement, and sim lab for IO placement. For Emergency Physician and Advanced Providers there will be concurrent workshops on emergency skills such as advanced airway management, central line insertion, FAST exams and chest tube insertion taught by experienced providers and the Idaho Simulation Network.

This conference will also give health care providers of children an opportunity to network, sharing ideas and experiences relating to the pediatric patients.
