



## 2018 Dedicated III Grants ~Vehicle Awards~

### FISCAL YEAR 2018 DEDICATED GRANT

Requests from EMS agencies for Fiscal Year 2018 Dedicated Grant totaled \$2,944,433.68 including \$1,797,361.71 for 17 vehicles and \$1,147,071.97 for equipment. The Dedicated Grant Fund is generated by a fee on driver's licenses and the Idaho Legislature appropriated \$1,400,000 for this year's disbursement. Of the total funds available, approximately 50% was awarded for vehicles and 50% was awarded for equipment.
