

## Agency Licensure Task Force Rule Language and Outline Development Draft

Who/Who not- Describes who is required to be licensed

### **Example One- Declarative**

- I. An Idaho EMS license is required for any individual or organization to advertise and/or respond to a request for EMS in Idaho.
  - a. Any individual or organization from a state other than Idaho that responds to requests originating in Idaho to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) within Idaho for pre-hospital or out-of-hospital medical care for the sick or injured.
- II. An individual or organization who advertises and /or responds requests for EMS in Idaho is not required to be licensed under the following conditions.
  - a. An individual or organization is a licensed agency in a state that has a current Interstate Agreement for Ambulance Licensure with Idaho.
  - b. An individual or organization is a licensed agency in a state and has been requested to respond in Idaho as a resource during a declared disaster.

### **Example Two- Question/Answer**

- I. Who is required to be licensed to provide EMS in Idaho?
  - a. You are required to be licensed if you;
    - i. Advertise you are available to respond to requests for EMS in Idaho.
    - ii. Respond to requests for EMS in Idaho
- II. What types of entities can become licensed as Idaho EMS Agencies?
  - a. Any individual or organization can become licensed as an EMS agency if they meet all of the Idaho EMS agency licensing requirements.
- III. Are there any conditions where an Idaho EMS agency license is not required to respond in Idaho?
  - a. Yes, under the following conditions a Idaho EMS License is not required;
    - i. You are licensed in another state that has an interstate agreement with Idaho for EMS.
    - ii. You are licensed in another state and have been requested to respond as a resource during a declared disaster in Idaho.
