

ICF/ID Behavior Review Form

Related diagnosis- contributes to understanding of behavior/ person (demographics). (W212)	Observed behavior (hit, kick, spit, etc.) - in measurable & observable terms, and baseline. (W231)	Function of Behavior- potential causes that elicit & sustain the behavior (i.e. attention seeking, history of punishing experiences, psychiatric symptom). (W214)	Reactive Intervention/ Objective- based on assmt, includes methods. (W227, W234, W239)	Proactive Strategy- including replacement behavior to elicit (+) behavior. (W239)	Data Collection- method and frequency, sufficient to assess progress/regress.(W237)	Behavior Modifying Drugs- purpose of the medication and plan for reduction. (W312) (See Record Review Form)

- Does the Dx match the behavior?
- Do the antecedent events match the function of the behavior?
- Are there objectives for all identified behaviors?
- Are the replacement behaviors appropriate based on the function of the behavior?
- Are intervention methods appropriate (i.e., environmental controls are included, intervention strategies are build in for antecedent behaviors, interventions are appropriate to the maladaptive behaviors displayed)?
- Is the assessment congruent with what was observed and what staff said?
