Alarm Tracking Form

Bed and/or chair alarms may be indicated as a diagnostic tool in fall risk assessment and management. Alarms should be used for determining patterns, trends, identifying patient needs, and establishing a plan of care. Note: Alarms should only be used on a short-term basis.
