	<b>PSR Supervision</b>		
16.03.10.130.06.b	<i>The agency must provide staff with adequate supervision to insure that the tasks on the individualized treatment plan can be implemented effectively.</i>		
16.03.10.130.06	<p><i>Agency staff person without a <u>Master's Degree</u> must be supervised by an individual with a Master's degree or higher.</i></p> <p><i>CPRP may provide supervision to PSR Specialist applicants who are working toward their CPRP credential when the certified professional is supervised by a Master's level staff person.</i></p> <p><i>*to contract or work for a PSR agency you must qualify under the staff qualification requirements.</i></p>
