NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK WAIVER RENEWALS SOLICITATION OF PUBLIC INPUT

Pursuant to 42 C.F.R. § 441.304, the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare Division of Medicaid (Department) provides public notice of its intent to seek renewal for Idaho's Adult Developmental Disabilities §1915(c) Waiver and Idaho's Aged and Disabled §1915(c) Waiver from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

CHANGE IN METHODOLOGY TO REIMBURSE RESIDENTIAL HABILITATION PROVIDERS

These renewal applications propose, among other minor changes, to change the methodology used to reimburse residential habilitation providers. Pursuant to 42 C.F.R. § 441.304 and 42 C.F.R. § 447.205, public notice of the proposed residential habilitation reimbursement change was first published on November 15, 2016 and November 16, 2016 in the newspapers of widest circulation in each Idaho city with a population of 50,000 or more and on the Department's website. At that time, copies of the public notice and the proposed residential habilitation reimbursement change were made available for public review on the Department's website and during regular business hours at any regional or field office of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare and any regional or local public health district office. In Adams, Boise and Camas counties, copies of the proposed residential habilitation reimbursement changes were available at each county clerk's office. The public was given the opportunity to comment on the proposed reimbursement change for a period of at least 30 days.
