Examination Policy 07-02
EMT-Basic Exam Eligibility for Candidates 17 Years of Age



Purpose: To enable 17 year olds to obtain Idaho EMT-Basic certification.

1. **NREMT Cognitive Examination** - EMT-Basic candidates who are 17 years of age that have successfully completed an Idaho EMS Bureau approved EMT-Basic course are eligible to take the National Registry of EMT's (NREMT) computer adaptive assessment examination at the EMT-B level.
 2. **Psychomotor Examination** - EMT-Basic candidates who are 17 years of age that have successfully completed an Idaho EMS Bureau approved EMT-Basic course are eligible to take an Idaho approved EMT-Basic psychomotor (practical) examination.
 3. **Idaho Certification** - EMT-Basic candidates who are 17 years of age that have successfully completed the NREMT cognitive and Idaho psychomotor examinations and meet all other certification requirements may apply for certification as an Idaho EMT-Basic.
 4. **NREMT Registration** - Idaho certified EMT-Basic providers who are 17 years of age may apply to the NREMT for full recognition once they turn 18 (NREMT fees and policies apply).
