




Percent of Total Land Ownership

Bear Lake County is located in southeastern Idaho, bordering Utah and Wyoming. It ranks 36th among Idaho counties in population and 32nd in area. About 7.4 percent, or 78.1 sq. miles, of the county is water. Approximately 46 percent of the county is federally owned. Services, trade, and government dominate the employment base. Annual average total civilian employment grew 8.6 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers of the area include Bear Lake Memorial Hospital, Bear Lake County School District, Bear Lake County government, Walton Feed Incorporated, Bear Lake Motor Co., Alco Discount Store, Peterson's IGA, Brolims Foodtown, and Jensen Lumber.

Points of interest include beautiful Bear Lake and the Minnetonka Cave.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007





Poison Control Calls for CY2006






Collision History 2004-2006

Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)










EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008




EMS Specialized Team Capabilities

Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008












All Transport and Non Transport Agency Submissions




### Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants

Number of Requests and Awards and Dollar Amount of Vehicle Grants Awarded




### Dedicated Fund Equipment Grants
