





Benewah County is located in northern Idaho, bordering Washington State. It ranks 28th among Idaho counties in population and 34th in area. The federal government owns about 10 percent of the county. Forest products manufacturing, trade, and government provide the foundation for the local economy. Annual average total civilian employment increased 6.0 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Potlatch Corporation, St. Maries Joint School District, Regulus Stud Mill, Jack A. Buell Trucking, Benewah Community Hospital, Valley Vista Care, Stimson Lumber, and the Coeur d'Alene Tribe.

Benewah County is home to the Coeur d'Alene Tribe and the Coeur d'Alene Indian Reservation. Skiing is available at North-South Ski Bowl.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007





Poison Control Calls for CY2006






Collision History 2004-2006

Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure






EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008



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








All Transport and Non Transport Agency Patient Care Report Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants

Number of Requests and Awards and Dollar Amount of Vehicle Grants Awarde




Dedicated Fund Equipment Grants
