





Bonner County is located in northern Idaho, bordering Washington and Montana. It ranks 8th among Idaho counties in population, and 19th in area. It has the largest water area of all Idaho counties, with water making up about 9.5 percent, or 183 square miles, of the county's surface. The federal government owns approximately 44 percent of the county. Forest products manufacturing, tourism, and mail-order catalog retailing are major components of the local economy, sustaining employment in retail trade, services and government. Annual average total civilian employment grew 34.2 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Litehouse, Bonner General Hospital, JD Lumber Co., Coldwater Creek, Riley Creek Lumber Co., Schweitzer Mountain Ski Resort, Wal-Mart, Quest Aircraft, and Unicep Packaging.

Lake Pend Oreille, Priest Lake, Cabinet Gorge, and other waterways provide limitless opportunities for recreation. Excellent skiing is available at Schweitzer Mountain Ski Resort.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007





Poison Control Calls for CY2006






Collision History 2004-2006

Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)






EMS Agency Structure






EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008












All Transport and Non Transport Agency Patient Care Report Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
