





Franklin County is located in southeastern Idaho, bordering Utah. It ranks 23rd among Idaho counties in population and 37th in area. The federal government owns nearly 33 percent of the county. Agriculture is the major basic industry, with government, services, trade and manufacturing providing the largest employment opportunities. Annual average total civilian employment in the county grew 40.6 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include the Preston and West Side school districts, Franklin County Regional Medical Center, Bear River Publishing, Freedom Plastics Inc., Pacific Power & Light, Ritewood, Inc., West Motor Company, Inc., Stokes Thriftway, Lundahl Ironworks, Inc., Oxford Mountain Farms and Trails West Manufacturing.

The city of Franklin is the oldest town in the state. Visitors can follow the Pioneer Historic Byway through the county to catch the old western flavor of the region.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007










Collision History 2004-2006

Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)










EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008












All Transport and Non Transport Agency Patient Care Report Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
