





Idaho County is located in north-central Idaho, bordering Oregon and Montana. It ranks 20th among Idaho counties in population, and 1st in area. The federal government owns over 83 percent of the county. Forest products manufacturing and agriculture are the basic industries, but government is the largest employment sector. Trade and services also provide substantial employment. Annual average total civilian employment increased 15.5 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Bennett Lumber Products, Clearwater Forest Industries, Department of Corrections - State Penitentiary, Grangeville Joint School District, Idaho County government, Seubert Excavators, Inc., St. Mary's Hospital - Cottonwood, Syringa General Hospital District, Three Rivers Timber, Inc., and the U.S. Forest Service.

The county contains the Selway-Bitterroot Wilderness Area, the Gospel Hump Wilderness area, the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness Area, and a large part of the Hells Canyon National Recreation Area. Approximately 165 miles of the nation's longest free-flowing river (the Salmon) wind through Idaho County. Also of note is the Nez Perce National Historic Park and the Lolo Indian Trail that Lewis and Clark followed.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007





Poison Control Calls for CY2006





Collision History 2004-2006



Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure






EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008












All Transport and Non Transport Agency Patient Care Report Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
