





Jerome County is located in south-central Idaho, bordering the Snake River. It ranks 17th among Idaho counties in population and 38th in area. The federal government owns about 25 percent of the county. Agriculture dominates the local economy, but trade, government, and services provide substantial employment. Annual average total civilian employment grew 22.0 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Hilex Poly, Progressive Logistics, Standlee Hay, Darigold, Jerome Cheese, Aardema Dairy, St. Benedict's Medical Center, Giltner Inc., Wal-Mart, Spears Manufacturing, Jerome and Valley school districts, City of Jerome, Jerome County government, Rite Stuff Foods and Arlo G. Lott Trucking Inc.

Shoshone Falls, the "Niagara of the West" is on the Snake River at the southern edge of the county. Plunging 212 feet, it is 52 feet higher than Niagara Falls. Views of the falls can be accessed on the Twin Falls County side of the river. The city of Jerome also boasts the Jerome County Historical Museum.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007





Poison Control Calls for CY2006






Collision History 2004-2006

Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008










All Transport and Non Transport Agency Patient Care Report Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
