





Nez Perce County is located in central Idaho, bordering Washington at the confluence of the Snake and Clearwater Rivers. It ranks 9th among Idaho counties in population and 33rd in area. Only 6.2 percent of the county is federal land, the second lowest of all Idaho counties. Paper and wood products manufacturing form the foundation of the local economy. Trade and transportation are also important due to the influence of the Port of Lewiston, Idaho's only seaport. Annual average total civilian employment decreased 16.6 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Potlatch Corporation, ATK, City of Lewiston, Lewiston Independent School District, Lewis-Clark State College, Nez Perce County government, Nez Perce Tribal Executive Commission, Tribune Publishing Company, Twin City Foods Inc., Wal-Mart and St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center.

The Snake and Clearwater Rivers provide extensive river recreation opportunities. This area is the major gateway to Hells Canyon, the deepest gorge in North America.





Presence of a Post-secondary Educational Institution and the EMS Program within the Institution




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007






Poison Control Calls for CY2006






Collision History 2004-2006

(gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/ Non-Transport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008












All Transport and Non-Transport Agency PCR Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
