





Oneida County is located in south-eastern Idaho, bordering Utah. It ranks 39th among Idaho counties in population and 26th in area. The federal government owns over 53 percent of the county. Government is the largest source of employment, with agriculture and mining the most significant basic industries. Trade and services also provide important employment. Annual average total civilian employment grew 31.8 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Hess Pumice Products, Inc., Hess Lumber, Inc., Idaho Milling and Grain, Moss Trucking, Ireland Bank, Malad Living Center, Oneida County School District, Oneida County Hospital, Oneida County government, Malad Valley Medical Clinic and Malad Nursing Home.

The county contains the Curlew National Grassland, the only such area in Idaho.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007






Poison Control Calls for CY2006






Collision History 2004-2006

 (gravel is considered improved)










EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/ Non-Transport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008












All Transport and Non-Transport Agency PCR Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
