



Owyhee County is located in southwestern Idaho, bordering Oregon and Nevada. It ranks 25th among Idaho counties in population and 2nd in area. The federal government owns nearly 76 percent of the county. Agriculture along the Snake and Bruneau Rivers forms the economic base, and government and trade provide additional employment. Annual average total civilian employment grew 5.9 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Filler King Company, Nederend Dairy, Deruyter Dairy, J.R. Simplot Company, Paul's Market, the school districts of Bruneau-Grandview, Homedale and Marsing, Owyhee County government and OwyheeHealth and Rehabilitation.

Bruneau Dunes State Park contains North America's tallest sand dunes at 470 feet. Bruneau Canyon, with its bighorn sheep population, lies to the south. The Duck Valley Indian Reservation, home of the Shoshone-Paiute Tribe, is on the Nevada border.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007








Poison Control Calls for CY2006





 (gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/ Non-Transport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008




EMS Specialized Team Capabilities










All Transport and Non-Transport Agency PCR Submissions




Dedicated Vehicle Grants
