





Payette County is located in southwestern Idaho, bordering the Snake River and the state of Oregon. It ranks 13th among Idaho counties in population and 44th in area. The federal government owns 25 percent of the county. Agriculture, food processing and forest products manufacturing are the basic sectors of the economy, with trade, government and services providing significant additional employment. Annual average total civilian employment grew 6.6 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Idaho Power Company, Partners Produce, Inc., Woodgrain Millwork, Dickinson Frozen Foods, American Staffing, Inc., Fruitland, New Plymouth and Payette school districts, Payette County government and Seneca Foods.

Each year in early May the Apple Blossom Festival is celebrated in the City of Payette.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007










Collision History 2004-2006

(gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure






EMS Agency Classification



EMS Agency Structure Transport/ Non-Transport




EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008










All Transport and Non-Transport Agency PCR Submissions




### Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
