




Percent of Total Land Ownership

Shoshone County is located in northern Idaho, bordering Montana. It ranks 22nd among Idaho counties in population and 8th in area. The federal government owns nearly 75 percent of the county. While mining is the traditional economic foundation of the county, growth in tourism and recreation are reflected in expanding employment in trade and services. Government is also a significant employer. Annual average total civilian employment in the county decreased 9.9 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Galena Mine, Sunshine Mine, Shoshone Medical Center, Silver Mountain Resort, Magnuson Hospitality, Dave Smith Motors, the U.S. Forest Service, the school districts, Wal-Mart and Lucky Friday Mine.

Silver Mountain Ski Resort, home of the world's longest single-stage gondola, is a popular visitor destination. Museums and mine tours offer opportunities to explore the area's rich mining history.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007





Poison Control Calls for CY2006






Collision History 2004-2006

(gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure






EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/ Non-Transport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008












All Transport and Non-Transport Agency PCR Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants

Number of Requests, Awards and Dollar Amount of Vehicle Grants Awarded




Dedicated Fund Equipment Grants
