






Washington County is located in southwestern Idaho, bordering the Snake River and Oregon. It ranks 27th among Idaho counties in population and 20th in area. The federal government owns 37 percent of the county. Agriculture, along with forest and food products manufacturing are the basic industries, while government and trade are other important sources of employment. Annual average total civilian employment grew 16.6 percent from 1996 to 2006. Large employers include Ridley's, Hometown Ford, Weiser Memorial Hospital, Appleton Produce, Cambridge, Midvale and Weiser school districts, Washington County government, City of Weister and Champion Home Builders.

The county hosts the National Old-Time Fiddlers contest each June. As the premier fiddling competition in the country, it draws fiddlers and spectators from throughout the nation.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007










Poison Control Calls for CY2006








EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/ Non-Transport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008




EMS Specialized Team Capabilities

Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008












All Transport and Non-Transport Agency PCR Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
