

Pharmacy & Therapeutics Committee Members

The Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee evaluates, educates and advises the Idaho Medicaid Program on its prescription drug policy. The Committee reviews evidence-based clinical and pharmacoeconomic data and recommends to the Department which agents will be designated as preferred within selected drug classes. Prior authorization criteria are reviewed by the Committee based on a drug's relative therapeutic merits, safety and cost.
