



ACCESS TO RECOVERY

Access to Recovery 4 (ATR4) will provide approximately \$2.2 million per year for treatment and recovery support services across multiple populations, including homeless individuals and families.

Services available include:

- Outpatient Services
(Individual, Group, Family Counseling)
- Case Management
- Safe and Sober Housing
- Drug Testing
- Transportation for Treatment Services
- Life Skills
- Recovery Coaching

Eligible populations will meet the following criteria:

- Income less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Rate in the past 30 days
- Assessment shows client meets clinical eligibility
- Homeless within the past 30 days according to ATR4 Definition of Homelessness

How do my clients access this funding?

Community-based organizations working with homeless individuals or families will help clients contact Business Psychology Associates for a phone screening. The Division of Behavioral Health will announce when funding is available. Referrals to ATR4 begin in early 2015.
