**SUBJECT:** Veteran Access to ATR 4

Currently, ATR 4 is available to the following populations:

- Veterans on supervised parole or probation
- Child Protection families involved with Child Protection Drug Court
- Individuals and families experiencing homelessness

Thanks to feedback from the community, veterans who are not on supervised probation or parole will now have access to ATR 4 funding if they are unable to access VA benefits because of discharge status, location, war/combat experience, or other concerns.

Effective immediately, clients can be referred to the ATR 4 program as follows:

- Supervised Veterans – Veteran Court Coordinator, Felony Parole/Probation Officer, or a Misdemeanor Probation Officer refers clients using the Funding Profile Form located at [www.bpahealth.com](http://www.bpahealth.com)
- Veterans – Community-based service providers assist clients in calling BPA for a phone screening at (800) 922-3406
- Child Protection Clients – CPS Liaisons or a Child Protection Drug Court Coordinator refers clients using the Funding Profile Form located at [www.bpahealth.com](http://www.bpahealth.com)
- People Experiencing Homelessness – Community-based service providers assist clients in calling BPA for a phone screening at (800) 922-3406
